Please help us to continue to maintain a safe environment at our school by discussing with your child acceptable behaviors that support a positive school climate, responsible use of social media, and ways to resolve conflict in a safe manner to avoid serious disciplinary actions and/or criminal charges.

We are talking with students to remind them to make sound decisions in school as well as to and from school. We are committed to providing a safe environment conducive to teaching and learning for our staff and students at Charles H. Flowers High School.
